Intro – Our text today is about a Canaanite woman. This group of people had come under God's wrath because of their ungodly worship of Satanic things and evil rituals. 4500 yr old altar for child sacrifice.

- I. The Canaanite woman should not have existed. Deut.7:2
 - A. Her child was possessed.
 - 1. Children are influenced by what we do and say. Prov.22:16
 - 2. You will be held responsible for what you teach your children. Matt.18:6
 - B. The woman was not regretting the error of her ways. Num.32:23
- II. She had come to believe Jesus was the Savior of all mankind.
 - A. "Son of David" was the title the Jews used for the Messiah. Matt.12:23, Matt.21:9 B." Lord help me"
 - 1. The Messiah had been promised to the Jewish people. (24) Jn.1:41, Jn.4:25
 - 2. She believed He would help her also. Eph.3:3-6, Rom.10:3, Rev.5:9
- III. A sincere faith changes things.
 - A. Jesus tested her faith. Peter Matt.16:16
 - B. She passed every test. (27) Jn.14:15
