Intro – What if God did not keep His promises? Then life would be meaningless. Let's look at the promises He made to Abram.

- I. God calls Abram to follow Him.
 - A. Leave your homeland. Heb.11:8, 1Jn.2:15
 - B. Leave your parents and relatives. Gen.22:12, Rom.4:21-22
 - C. When God calls you to salvation you need to be willing to leave all behind. Matt.10:37
- II. God makes promises to Abram.
 - A. A specific piece of land. Gen.13:15, Gen.15:18, Jacob Gen.35:12, Moses Ex.23:31
 - B. He would bless him.
 - 1. He would be a great nation. Ezk.37:21-22, Ezk.39:28
 - 2. His name would be great. Christians, Jews, Muslims all honor Abraham.
 - 3. All the families of the earth shall be blessed. Lk.2:10-11, Gal.3:8, Acts 3:25
- III. God has kept and will keep every promise He has made.
 - A. God cannot lie. Heb.6:18-19
 - B. This is why we have assurance and hope. Heb.13:8
 - C. Some promises are yet to be fulfilled. Rom.11:1-2
 - 1. Help at Armageddon. Zech. 14:2-4, Rev.19:11,16,19-20
 - 2. Other nations will serve the Jews. Is.60:3-5, 12, Zech.14:16, Is.2:2, Jer.3:17
