 - 1. Through compromise. Num.23:25
 - 2. Through bad advice. Rev.2:14
 - C. Balaam is punished. 2 Pet.2:15-16, Num.31:8

 - A. Be like Balaam and seek for ways to get around God's will?
 - B. Or will you repent and follow God's will?
