 - A. Gods who could not help them. Jer.2:27-28
 - B. They cannot help you. Ps.115:4-8, Deut.18:11
 - C. They cannot provide for you. Jer.10:4, Jn.14:13-14
- III. Where do you stand?
 - A. Are you forsaking Godly principals? 1Tim.6:12
 - B. Are you backsliding spiritually? Acts 3:19
